JUMPERS

JUMPER CLASSES: In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP112. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper divisions. Table II, 2(c) classes - power phase to be timed. * indicates bonus point class. Horses must show in at least one (1) other class in their respective division at this show to be eligible for a Stake or Classic. Grand Prix horses must have shown in at least one (1) 1.35m or 1.40m Open Jumper Class at this show to be eligible for the Grand Prix. Riders must ride for awards in the Grand Prix, Stake Classes and Classics to be awarded the prize money.

National Standard. Course to consist of at least one double and one triple combination (or three doubles); at least two verticle obstacles of not less than 4'11; at least eleven obstacles at minimum height of 4'6; and at least three spreads of 5' to 5'3. Riders must ride for awards or prize money will be forfeited.

JUMPER ATTIRE: Riders are not required to wear Hunt Coats, except where stated. Sweaters or shirts with a collar only will be acceptable. Hunt coats are required in Classics, Stake Classes and Special Classes.

No work off is required; but further testing is at the judge's discretion. (USEF tests 1 - 19) Points awarded to top eight riders; 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Riders will receive double points in classes with 15 or more riders. Six points required to qualify a rider for the Medal Finals. Winner may continue to compete throughout the year. Five riders must complete the course.

Class is open to Junior & Amateur riders not showing in any classes over 3'6 in height. To be judged over a Jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 3' in height. To be judged on hands, seat guidance & control of the horse on a Jumper type of ride. No time allowed; a tone will be used to signal the rider to start the course. Any Jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties per USEF Equitation rules. Additional work-off after the initial round will be at the Judge's discretion, and any number of riders may be asked to test. At least 3 riders must enter & show in the class. First & second place winners will qualify for the finals.

The Pickwick Medal Jr/Am (3'6)	729	\$45

To be shown over a jumper course of not less than eight fences approx. 3'6 in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance & control of the horse. Jumper-type horses are encouraged, and jumper equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties are to be considered in accordance with the USEF hunter seat equitation rules. There will be no work-off. Four contestants are required for the class to count. Points will be awarded (7-5-4-3-2-1), and 7 points qualify for the finals to be held at the Pickwick Fall Show in September. Classes with more than 15 contestants will count double. Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded the top three riders in each qualifying class. Contestants may continue to compete in the class throughout the year. A special award will be presented to the rider earning the most points in Pickwick Medal Classes held between October 2009 and the 2010 Pickwick Medal Finals.
