## HMI EQUESTRIAN CHALLENGE • MAY 17 - 21, 2017

JUMPER CLASSES: In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP112. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper divisions. Table II, 2(c) classes - power phase to be timed. \* Indicates bonus point class. Horses must show in at least one (1) other class in their respective division at this show to be eligible for a Classic. Grand Prix horses must have shown in at least one (1) 1.30m - 1.45m Jumper Class at this show to be eligible for the Grand Prix. Riders must ride for awards in the Grand Prix and Classics to be awarded the prize money. Horses do not need to show in a class to qualify to show in the Open Jumper Classics. See Rule 34.

JUMPER ATTIRE: Formal Jumper Attire required in Grand Prix, Classics and Special Classes. Standard Jumper Attire required in all other jumper classes. USEF JP111.9

The Green Hunter Incentive Program (formerly Pre-Green Incentive Program) for horses competing at 3'0" or 3'3" is an innovative program designed to encourage the development of green horses. The annual Championship will be held the same week as the USHJA International Hunter Derby Championship. The Green Hunter Incentive Program is open to horses of any age that are eligible to compete as a green hunter at 3'0" or 3'3" fence heights under Federation rules. Horses must be enrolled in the USHJA Green Hunter Incentive Program and pay the annual enrollment fee to participate in the Green Hunter Stake classes and to be eligible for the Green Hunter Championship. Horses must be registered with USHJA and recorded with USEF to participate. Horses must be enrolled in the Green Hunter Incentive Program prior to competing in a Green Hunter Stake class.

Karen Healey is one of the most decorated horse trainers of all time. Throughout her 40+ year career, she has developed a multitude of top riders, including European champion and three-time FEI World Cup champion Meredith Michaels-Beerbaum, the only woman to be first in the world rankings. Her students have won 100+ medal finals including the ASPCA Maclay National Finals and a record 13 USET Talent Search Finals. Karen has trained numerous National Champions in both the hunter and jumper divisions and gold medalists at the NAJYRC and the Prix de States.

Karen's contributions to our sport extend far beyond her legendary show record. She has been instrumental in the administration and evolution of show jumping. Karen has served as chairperson of the hunt seat equitation task force and sat on the trainer's certification committee, the officials' education committee and the open hunter task force. She is a founding member of the USHJA Trainer Certification Program (TCP) and a clinician with the USHJA Emerging Athletes Program. Additionally, Karen holds a USEF R-rated judging license and has judged some of the most prestigious shows in the country. In 1991 Karen was named Horsewoman of the Year by the California Professional Horseman's Association and in 2007 the Chronicle of the Horse Person of the Year.

Complications from a recent back surgery have left Karen in and out of the hospital and a physical rehab center. The CPHA Foundation has established a fund to accept tax deductible donations on her behalf. The Karen Healey Open Equitation Challenge is a special competition designed and judged by Karen Healey - in lieu of entry fees we ask participants to make a minimum donation of \$100 to help fund Karen's ongoing medical expenses. Additionally, throughout HMI Equestrian Challenge, Sonoma Horse Park will pay tribute to Karen, her exceptional career and contributions to our sport. On Saturday, May 20th, we will host a fundraiser and auction to raise critical funds for Karen's recovery. The VIP will be open to all and complimentary dinner and wine tasting will be served in conjunction with the Grand Prix. We encourage all show attendees to attend.

Karen to judge competition; further testing is at her discretion. Special awards presented to the top 10 finishers. Riders must ride for awards.

To be shown over a hunter or jumper course of 3' fences with two tests included in the course. Five riders to fill. Points awarded: 7-5-4-3-2-1. If only four finish, points will be awarded 5-3-2-1 and if only three finish the points will be 4-2-1. No points if fewer than three riders complete the course. If fifteen or more riders complete the course points will be 10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2. Five points qualifies for the finals in October. Previous winners of the Horse & Hound Jr/Amateur Medal Finals are no longer eligible to compete. No memberships required.

No work off is required; but further testing is at the judge's discretion (USEF tests 1-19). Points awarded to top eight riders: 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Riders will receive double points in classes with fifteen or more riders. Six points required to qualify a rider for the Medal Finals. Winner may continue to compete throughout the year. Five riders must complete the course. Finals take place at Strides & Tides (September 13 - 17, 2017). Hudson & Company Medal Finals winner to receive a CWD Saddle. No memberships required.

To be shown over a jumper course of no less than eight fences approximately 3'3 in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control of the horse. Jumper-type horses are encouraged, and jumper equipment is allowed. A time allowed will be based on a speed of 360 yards per minute. The judge will give a numerical score for each competitor's round. The announcer will announce the judge's numerical score and then deduct time faults as follows: One point for each commenced second over the time allowed. Three refusals. There will be no work-off. Four contestants are required for the class to count. Points awarded to top eight riders: 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Riders will receive double points in classes with fifteen or more riders. No memberships required.
