## JUMPERS

**JUMPER CLASSES:** In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place **will be broken by the fastest time**. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP112. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper divisions. Table II, 2(c) classes - power phase to be timed.

**JUMPER ATTIRE:** Riders are not required to wear Hunt Coats, except where stated. Sweaters or shirts with a collar only will be acceptable. **Hunt coats are required in Classics, Stake Classes and Special Classes.**

To be shown over a course of fences (Sm/Med to jump 2', Lg to jump 2'6) with 2 tests included. Points awarded 7-5-4-3-2-1. If only 4 finish, points will be awarded 5-3-2-1. 5 points qualifies for the finals in Oct. A sterling silver jumping horse pendant will be presented to the winner of a qualifying class with 5 or more entries. Classes with 15 or more entries will be pointed 10-8-7-6-5-4-3-2.

To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences 3'3 with two changes of direction and one combination which must include an oxer. 2 or more tests will be incorporated in the original course. No work-off is required. 5 points (7-5-4-3-2-1) qualifies for the finals. At least 4 riders must finish.

**Hudson & Company Medal Jr/Am (3'3)**

To be shown over a course of hunter and jumper type fences approximately 3'3 in height with flat work incorporated into the course. No work off is required; but further testing is at the judge's discretion. (USEF tests 1 - 19) Points awarded to top eight riders; 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1. Riders will receive double points in classes with 15 or more riders. Six points required to qualify a rider for the Medal Finals. Winner may continue to compete throughout the year. Five riders must complete the course.

**The Cloverleaf Equitation Classic (3')**

Class is open to Junior & Amateur riders not showing in any classes over 3'6 in height. To be judged over a Jumper course of not less than 9 fences at 3' in height. To be judged on hands, seat guidance & control of the horse on a Jumper type of ride. No time allowed; a tone will be used to signal the rider to start the course. Any Jumper type bit or equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties per USEF Equitation rules. Additional work-off after the initial round will be at the Judge's discretion, and any number of riders may be asked to test. At least 3 riders must enter & show in the class. First & second place winners will qualify for the finals.

**The Pickwick Medal Jr/Am (3'6)**

To be shown over a jumper course of not less than eight fences approx. 3'6 in height. To be judged on hands, seat, guidance & control of the horse. Jumper-type horses are encouraged, and jumper equipment is allowed. Jumping penalties are to be considered in accordance with the USEF hunter seat equitation rules. There will be no work-off. Four contestants are required for the class to count. Points will be awarded (7-5-4-3-2-1), and 7 points qualify for the finals to be held at the Pickwick Fall Show in September. Classes with more than 15 contestants will count double. Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded the top three riders in each qualifying class. Contestants may continue to compete in the class throughout the year. A special award will be presented to the rider earning the most points in Pickwick Medal Classes held between October 2009 and the 2010 Pickwick Medal Finals.
