



## Sonoma Horse Park Temperature Monitoring Log

**Daily medications that may affect temperature results:** Bute, Ketofen, Banamine, Dexamethasone, Dipyrone, Equioxx/Previcox

**Instructions:** Record the rectal body temperature of horse two times/day, every morning and evening. For accuracy it is recommended temperatures are recorded prior to administering daily medications and at least two (2) hours after shipping or strenuous exercise.
