Sonoma Horse Park Temperature Monitoring Log

Daily medications that may affect temperature results: Bute, Ketofen, Banamine
Dexamethasone, Dipyrone, Equioxx/Previcox

Instructions: Record the rectal body temperature of horse two times/day, every morning and evening. For accuracy it is recommended temperatures are recorded prior to administering daily medications and at least two (2) hours after shipping or strenuous exercise.
