In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP112. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper divisions. Table II, 2(c) classes - power phase to be timed. \* Indicates bonus point class. Horses must show in at least one other class in their respective division at this show to be eligible for a Classic. Grand Prix horses must show in at least one 1.30m - 1.45m Jumper Class at this show to be eligible for the Grand Prix. Riders must ride for awards in Grand Prix and Classics to be awarded the prize money. Horses do not need to show in a class to qualify to show in Open Jumper Classics. See Rule 34. Formal attire required in Grand Prix, Classics and Special Classes. USEF JP111.9

# USHJA OUTREACH RULES & SCHEDULE

SHP SPRING CLASSIC I · MAY 10 - 14, 2023 SHP SPRING CLASSIC II · MAY 17 - 21, 2023

The following classes are part of the 2023 USHJA Outreach Program. USEF and USHJA membership is not required to participate in an Outreach Competition or in any Outreach classes. Non-USEF and USHJA members will not be charged a Non-Member or Show Pass Fee. Riders and Trainers must be USHJA members at the free Outreach level or higher in order to be eligible for points toward year end awards. Hunter championships will be presented in each hunter section with the top four over fences earning under saddle points. Equitation championships will be presented in each equitation section with points counting equally for all classes. Combined section championships will be presented in each combined section with points counting equally for all classes. Ties broken by the most points over fences; if still tied, then most points in the equitation flat class.

HUNTER CLASSES: Hunter sections judged on performance and soundness. Manners shall be emphasized. Horses will not jog for soundness.

EQUITATION CLASSES: Riders may only ride one horse in an equitation class. To be judged on general horsemanship.

CROSS RAIL: Judged on suitability. No in and outs.

WALK TROT: Obstacles riders will be asked to ride over a course of obstacles at the walk and trot such as poles on the grounds and cones.

ATTIRE: Riders are required to wear approved protective head gear, riding boots and britches or jodhpurs.

BRAIDING: Please do not braid for the horse show. Horses/ponies will not be penalized for being braided.

- Fence heights for Table II.2.a classes will be 1.45m with spreads of 1.50m to 1.70m
- Each trial must offer one class scored under Table II Sec. 1 and one class scored under Table II Sec. 2(a)
- The 2nd and 3rd Trial (Table II.2.a classes) must have two (2) single obstacles (one vertical and one oxer) at 1.50m
- Courses must include at least one double and one triple combination (or three doubles)
- Speed of 375 meters/minute (350m/m for indoor venues)
- An open water jump is mandatory with a minimum of 12'(3.65m) spread
- It is mandatory that applicants be provided the opportunity to jump a water jump with or without a rail. The water must have a minimum of 12' spread in a class at the show on the day proceeding the first day of the Trial. The class must be held in the same ring as the Trial. Exception: Indoor trials are not required to have an open water.

- Minimum of \$5,000 in prize money in each Trial
- Fence heights for Table II.1 classes will be 1.35m

## **TECHNICAL DELEGATE**

There must be a technical delegate (TD) present at each of the trials. The TD will be responsible for interfacing with the Horse Show Management, Officials, and exhibitors. The TD is responsible for ensuring that the Zone 10 Selection Trials are conducted under the specifications and standards as described above. The TD will be appointed by the Zone 10 Committee. The Zone 10 Committee will be responsible for covering the expenses of the TD.

## PASSPORTS PRESENTATION AND TRAINING JOG

- There will be a passport inspection and mandatory training jog at each Selection Trial
- Horses intending to compete in the Zone 10 Selection Trials must be presented at the training jog
- The intent of the Training Jog is to prepare athletes and horses for future FEI Horse Inspections.
- The time and location will be determined by each Selection Trial host
- The training jog will be carried out by the Official Horse Show Veterinarian or the approved Zone 10 Trials Veterinarian, Steward, and Zone 10 Chef d'Equipe.
- Horses not accepted at the training jog may be re-presented at a time agreed upon by the Veterinarian, Steward, and Zone 10 Chef d'Equipe.
- Horses who are deemed unsound to compete following the re-inspection are prohibited from competing in any classes at the competition.
- The time and location will be determined by each Selection Trial host.
- Athlete/horse combinations will not be eliminated from the Selection
   Trial if their passport contains a deficiency or correction or if the athlete does not have one in their possession.
- All athletes must be neatly dressed and are strongly encouraged to wear a helmet.
- For extraordinary circumstances only, permission for a horse and/or athlete to be excused from the jog may be granted by the Zone Chairman and Technical Delegate.

### **SCHOOLING**

The same schooling rules will apply for a given Selection Trial as the class specifications for that Trial class determine (FEI or USEF).

# SONOMA HORSE PARK EQUINE HEALTH ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

## **EVENT PARTICIPATION DECLARATION - REQUIRED**

Signed by the owner/agent/trainer verifying that the horse has been healthy with no sign of infectious disease and has not had a fever above 102 °F within 72 hours (3days) of arrival. Required for all horses entering Sonoma Horse Park Show Grounds both Showing and Non-Showing. Event Participation Declaration Form available at sonomahorsepark.com. This documentation must be submitted <u>prior</u> to arrival to <u>biosecurity@sonomahorsepark.com</u> and hard copies <u>must</u> accompany all horses arriving at Sonoma Horse Park.

A new Event Participation Declaration Form must be filed each time the horse enters the property. Horses stabled off the property that ship-in for their classes must comply with this requirement.

## PROOF OF VACCINATION - REQUIRED

Signed statement from the attending veterinarian that the horse has been vaccinated against the following:

- Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: Equine Influenza (EIV)
- Within 6 months (180 days) of each show: Rhinopneumonitis (EHV 1 and EHV 4)
- · If a vaccination will expire during one of the shows, the horse must receive its new vaccination prior to being issued a competition number.

### PRESENTATION OF HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- The Equine Health Requirements are Required for all horses entering Sonoma Horse Park Show both Showing and Non-Showing. These documents must be filed in the Show Office before any competition numbers will be issued. All required papers must indicate the horse's registered show name. This documentation must be submitted <u>prior</u> to <u>arrival</u> to <u>biosecurity@sonomahorsepark.com</u> and hard copies <u>must</u> accompany all horses arriving at Sonoma Horse Park.
- All horses permanently stabled at Riverside Equestrian Center and showing at Sonoma Horse Park must meet these Health Requirements.
- Any horse not accompanied by these documents will be directed to the Show Veterinarian to obtain the required documents and/or vaccinations, and/or will be placed in quarantined stabling until proper documents are obtained. Any horse showing signs or fever/illness/stress is subject to examination by SHP Officials and/or the Show Veterinarian.

## **GR845 EQUINE VACCINATION RULE**

- 1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
- 2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration
- 3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
- 4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letter-head stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

# SONOMA HORSE PARK 2023 RULES & GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. "Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith."
- 2. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above & Combined Driving Competitions at Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) Leadline; 2) Exhibitions; 3) Games and races; 4) Classes for 4-H members; 5) Walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) Citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; 11) Assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. See GR901.

#### 3. RELEASES

- 3a. FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT: By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of the United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of the competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse from the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in NY State. See GR908.4.
- 3b. SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirements to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
- 3c. PCHA: The competition and its management agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the PCHA, its directors, officer, committee members, agents and employees from and against all loss or damage including any and all claims arising out of the competition, including claims as to personal injury or property loss or damage suffered during or in conjunction with competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from negligent acts or omissions of said directors, officers, committee members, agents or employees.
- 3d. SONOMA HORSE PARK: I HEREBY EXPRESSLY, VOLUNTARILY, AND UNCONDITIONALLY RELEASE, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS Howard Herman, Marcia Herman, Meredith Herman, Ashley Herman, Burgundy Farms, Riverside Equestrian Center, and/or Sonoma Horse Park, their owners, officers, members, agents, employees, licensees and invitees, as well as any other person, firm, corporation, company, entity, or anyone in any way connected with the ownership and management of the show premises and the Horse Show, or in control of the premises or equipment related thereto (collectively, "Releasees") from and against ANY AND ALL CLAIMS FOR INJURIES, DAMAGES, AND/OR LOSSES connected with participation in this Horse Show. This includes, but is not limited to, claims for monetary damages, attorney's fees, costs, losses, and/or causes of action against Releasees for any and all Harm to me or my horse(s) and for any Harm caused or contributed in any way to by me or my horse(s) to others, arising out of or in any way connected with participation in this Horse Show, and includes reimbursement of Releasees' costs and attorney's fees incurred in defense of such claims. I further agree to this release, indemnification, and holding harmless WHETHER OR NOT SUCH CLAIM, INJURY, DAMAGE, OR LOSS RESULTED, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, FROM MY NEGLIGENT ACTS OR OMISSIONS OR THE NEGLIGENT ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF RELEASEES, to the fullest extent allowed by law. I also acknowledge that no representations or warranties, whether oral or written, implied or expressed, have been made by Releasees concerning Horse Show premises, the Horse Show event, or activities at Burgundy Farms, Riverside Equestrian Center, and/or Sonoma Horse Park, or any other matter.
- 4. MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Manager reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules & Regulations shall be decided by the horse show manager; its decision to be final.

- 5. RESPONSIBILITY: Horse Show Manager reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes as competition warrants.
- 6. CONDITION OF ENTRY: Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Manager, but the horse show manager will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the individual horse shows and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities, Sonoma Horse Park, Riverside Equestrian Center, Giant Steps, and its employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of each horse show & the facilities at which each horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. All owners and exhibitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.
- 7. ENTRY PROCEDURES: Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, signatures and organizational membership numbers. Horses entered without classes may be put on a waiting list for classes if rings are fully subscribed. Entry blanks must be postmarked or submitted electronically (showgroudslive.com/shp) on or before the closing date of entries. Any entry entered after the closing date of entries will be charged a late fee. Late fee is \$75. For each horse entered, a non-refundable \$400 deposit fee will be charged to provided credit card. GR907.1 STALLS AND CLASSES MAY BECOME FULLY SUBSCRIBED BEFORE THE CLOSE OF ENTRIES.
- 8. NOMINATING FEE: All entries competing in jumper classes at 1.20m or higher must pay a \$125 Nomination Fee. All other entries pay a \$75 Nomination Fee. Classes scratched in horse show office on official add/scratch forms before the start of the class will receive a full refund. Scratch fees will still apply.
- 9. POST ENTRIES/SCRATCH FEES: Classes may be added up until 4:00 pm the day prior to the day of the class. A full class fee refund will be given to all classes scratched prior to start of the class (exception Special classes. See Rules 35 & 36). Horse Show Management reserves the right to limit entries at its discretion.
- 10. ENTRY BLANKS: Please enter each horse in its proper division or class. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents in making out entry blanks. In all cases the description on entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" shall not be accepted.
- A. Be properly signed, and in the case of a minor, be signed by a parent or guardian.
- B. Be made on an entry blank provided by the show.
- C. Show the correct mailing address of the owner.
- D. Social Security number must be included on entry blank.
- E. Include copy of USEF membership card for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer, coach, rider & handler.
- F. Include copy of USHJA membership card for each owner, lessee, agent, trainer, coach, rider & handler.
- G. Include all additional membership numbers and birth dates of junior and amateur riders. Provide photocopy of USEF amateur card.
- H. Provide photocopy of USEF pony measurement card for any ponies entered in the Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters, Pony Equitation and Pony Jumpers division. See rule 29.
- I. Provide photocopy of USEF measurement card for any Junior Hunter entered in hunter division. See rule 29.
- J. Payment for \$400 Deposit Fee.
- K. Credit card number, expiration date and signature must be included on the credit card form.
- 11. REFUNDS: All refund requests must be submitted in writing. Before close of entries, all fees will be refunded. After close of entries, no refunds given unless one of the following requirements is met:
- Prior to start of show, entry fees will be refunded less the stall fee and office fee.
- · After show starts, classes scratched in Horse Show Office before class has started will be refunded.
- After show starts, add and scratch fees for Classics, Grand Prix, Stakes & Special Classes will apply.
- 12. RETURNED CHECKS: Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a serious offense and will be handled in the following procedure. \$50 or 10% of the amount of the check will be assessed for each returned check. Accounts will be given 10 days to be paid in full with cash or cash equivalent, or they will be turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action. Credit Cards declined and charge-backs will be handled as above.
- 13. UNPAID CHARGES: If show management or official (i.e. farrier, veterinarian, feed supplier, photographer, food concessionaire, etc.) must bill an exhibitor for unpaid charges, a \$50 billing fee will be added to amount due.

- 14. PRIZE MONEY: Prize money not deducted from the statement will be made payable to owner listed on entry blank and mailed within 30 days after the show. PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE MAILED UNLESS THE OWNER'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER IS LISTED ON ENTRY BLANK. ANYONE REQUESTING 1099 CHANGES AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN MAILED WILL BE CHARGED \$100 TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE. PRIZE MONEY CHECKS NOT CASHED AFTER 90 DAYS WILL HAVE A STOP PAYMENT PLACED ON THEM AND EXHIBITOR WILL FORFEIT PRIZE MONEY. PRIZE MONEY WON BY FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Foreign exhibitors are advised that the U.S. Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to withhold 30% of prize money won in the United States. Foreign exhibitors should apply for a U.S. Social Security number and will be asked to complete form W-8 prior to Sonoma Horse Park. Horse Shows issuing prize money won.
- 15. PRIZES: Sonoma Horse Park will award ribbons from 1st to 8th place for all standard classes. The winner of each standard class will be awarded (1) self-selected prize from the options on display. All Featured Classes will be awarded ribbons from 1st to 12th, the winner will be awarded a prize along with the appropriate prize money. All Classics will be awarded ribbons 1st through 10th, with the winner receiving a prize as well as the appropriate prize money.
- 16. ADD-BACK: In classes with add-back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show.
- 17. CLOSE OUT: Entries not closed out by 8:00 AM on the Tuesday following the show will be charged a \$100 close-out fee.
- 18. ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE: Horses and grooms may arrive & depart within the days listed below:

#### SHP AUGUST CLASSIC • AUGUST 9 - 13, 2023

Arrivals can be accommodated ONLY between the hours of 8 AM and 6 PM. Arrive no earlier than Monday, 8:00 AM August 7, 2023
Departure by 7:00 PM Sunday, August 13, 2023

19. MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, or farm utility vehicles at Sonoma Horse Park. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. USEF GR1301.7. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule. USEF GR1301.8.

- 20. PARKING: Horse trailers will be parked in designated areas. Autos will also be parked in designated areas. No autos allowed in the barn aisles.
- 21. LIMITED RV SPACE: RV parking is available at \$475 per RV per show. Includes 30 amps of electricity, water and two pump-out services. If available, 50 amp spaces will be available for an additional \$100 per show. There are limited spaces available. RVs must park in designated area with a dated permit provided by the show. Permit must be visibly placed in windshield. RVs will be pumped on Thursday and Saturday Evenings. Reservations will be taken on a paid first come-first served basis.
- 22. STABLING: Requests for stalls for horses not entered in the show or for tack, feed or grooming may be reduced by management and refunds given, if there is a shortage of stalls. No straw allowed. Trainers will be responsible for payment of all stalls requested. Credit Card required to hold stalls. If stall request are taken, they will only be held until the close of entries.
- 23. STALLS: Exhibitors are responsible for the condition of the stalls upon departure. Anyone dismantling stalls or causing damage to a stall will be charged a \$100 fee per panel, with a maximum fine per stall of \$450. 10' x 10' stalls are wood or canvas with top and bottom doors. 10' x 12' stalls are 1/4 inch puck board with a single door. All stalls have dirt floors.
- 24. FEED & BEDDING: All feed orders received in Horse Show Office by NOON will be delivered the same day. Saturday feed orders must be in by NOON. No deliveries on Sunday. All feed orders must state barn and stall numbers. Feed and bedding will not be delivered without a signed open check or credit card number on file at the Horse Show Office. Any discrepancies in orders must be reported to the show office the day of delivery or refunds cannot be guaranteed.
- 25. MEDICAL WASTE: Needles must be placed in the proper receptacles. Receptacles are proved by management and are located in each barn aisle. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a \$100 fine or other penalties deemed necessary by show management. USEF GR1210.4
- 26. NUMBERS: Management will provide a number card for each competitor which shall be worn on the rider's back for hunters and equitation and on the saddle pad or visible on tack for jumpers clearly visible to the judge at all times when in competition. Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all may be eliminated from the class by the judge.
- 27. COURSES: Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post & Rails, Banks, Ditches, Coups & Liverpools. The horse show management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads in jumper classes as competition warrants.
- 28. HARD HATS AND ATTIRE: USEF GR801 will be strictly enforced. It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. GR801.2 All exhibitors are required to wear shoes or boots with a riding heel whenever mounted on horseback on the grounds. GR801.9
- 29. MEASURING OF ENTRIES: Time of measuring will be posted in the Horse Show Office. ALL HUNTER AND JUMPER PONIES, JUNIOR HUNTERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF OR THEIR ORIGINAL MEASUREMENT CARDS PRESENTED TO ONE OF THE SHOW SECRETARIES OR BE MEASURED IF THE CARD IS NOT AVAILABLE, BEFORE THE EXHIBITORS' NUMBER WILL BE RELEASED.
- 30. SCHOOLING SUPERVISION: Please be advised that the starters are schooling supervisors and have absolute authority to scratch riders who do not follow USEF schooling rules. They can scratch riders without going through the USEF Steward or the Horse Show Manager.
- 31. DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7. See USEF GR1301.6 Loose dogs will be picked up and detained until the owner has paid a fine of \$50. A second offense may cause the owner to be barred from showing and expelled from the show grounds. Refusal to pay the fine will bar the owner from further participation in the horse show and the owner will not be entitled to any refund of entry or stabling fees paid or due. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
- 32. TIME SCHEDULE/POSTED ORDER: Each evening, time schedule for the next day's schedule is available. This time schedule will be strictly adhered to. Trainer, exhibitor or representative must tell the paddock steward of possible ring conflicts so arrangements can be made to accommodate the rider and time schedule. All Hunter and Jumper orders will be drawn according to USEF Rule JP112. Posted orders for Grand Prix, Hunter and Jumper Classics, Hunter and Jumper Derbies will be strictly adhered to. All Horse Show Manager decisions will be final.
- 33. LUNGING: Lunging is NOT permitted in the following arenas: Grand Prix Arena, Grand Prix Warm-Up Arena, Jumper 2 Arena, Main Hunter Arena, Hunter 2 Arena, Hunter 3 Arena and Hunter 4 Arena. The trainer will be fined \$500 each time anyone is caught lunging in any of these arenas. The \$500 penalty fee will be added to trainer's show bill and is expected to be paid upon check out.

- 34. ARENAS: Grand Prix Arena: Textile 350' x 220', Main Hunter Arena: Textile 275' x 165', Jumper 2 Arena: Textile 300' x 160', Hunter 2 Arena: Textile 260' x 160', Hunter 3 Arena: Textile 240' x 140', Hunter 4 Arena: Textile 240' x 150'.
- 35. JUMPER GRAND PRIX & CLASSICS: Grand Prix: Horses must declare by 1:00 PM the day before the Grand Prix, Derby & Classics. A late fee will be charged if entered after 1:00 PM the day before class is held. A \$100 scratch fee will be charged if the Grand Prix and/or Derby are scratched the day class is held. Classics scratched the day of Classic will pay either \$100, \$75 or \$50 scratch fee (see class list for classic penalty fee).
- 36. HUNTER CLASSICS: Horses entered the day of Classic will pay a late fee. To be eligible, horses must have entered, shown and completed the course in at least 2 classes in the Hunter section. Classics scratched day of the Classic will pay a scratch fee (see class list for classic penalty fee).
